Pharmacy Technician Training

Ohio now requires all pharmacy technicians to pass a competency exam. Receive the training you need to become a Certified Pharmacy Technician (CPhT). This course is designed to give you the knowledge and skills needed to be successful on the CPhT exam administered by the national Pharmacy Technician Certification Board. The certification provides career opportunities in community pharmacies, hospitals and various other health care facilities. Topics include terminology, calculations, routes and formulations, parenterals, compounding, and much more.

State Tested Nurse Aide (STNA) Training

This is the 80 hour course approved by the state of Ohio for students wishing to obtain jobs in any long term care facility in the state of Ohio. Trainees completing the course will be eligible to take the state skills and written exam that will place them on the state registry for nursing assistants. (After completing the course and test in Ohio, many states accept reciprocity).

The course consists of classroom instruction, lab in a simulated resident room and a minimum of 16 clinical hours in an actual long term care facility under the direct supervision of a qualified instructor. This training also qualifies a student to become a home health aide. State testing for STNAs is available at Terra Community College once each month.
