Scholarship Money Still Available for Fall Semester at Terra Community College

The Financial Aid Department at Terra Community College has some good news for those who want to pursue a couple of specific careers. There is still scholarship money available for fall semester.

The Society of Plastics Engineers contributes to an endowment which offers \$10,000 in scholarships each year to students in the plastics technology program. So far this year, only one \$1,000 scholarship has been awarded.

Also, students who would like to become math or science teachers are being encouraged to apply for ACTION scholarships. These awards include \$2,000 per year for the first two years of study at Terra and then \$3,500 and \$4,250, respectively, for the next two years at either Bowling Green State University or the University of Findlay.

Terra has already awarded more than \$128,000 in scholarships for the 2009-2010 academic year, according to Ed Recker, Director of Financial Aid.

"Unfortunately we don't have money left for everyone, but students in plastics and math and science pre-education are in luck," he said. "And it's not too late to come in and apply for these awards."
