

**AGREEMENT OF ARTICULATION**  
**Effective Beginning with 2009 Graduates**

This agreement is based on a review of the following programs at EHOVE Career Center and courses taught in the Engineering and Industrial Division at Terra State Community College as of the date of this agreement.

*Auto Technology*  
*Diesel Truck*  
*Carpentry*  
*Electrical Trades*  
*Manufacturing Technology*  
*Visual Communications Design*

Faculty and administrative review, discussion and evaluation of course content establish the following agreement:

Students completing one of the above programs at EHOVE Career Center will receive articulated credit at Terra State Community College upon completing the following criteria:

1. Apply and be accepted for admission to Terra State Community College.
2. Submit official high school transcripts to the Records Office at Terra State Community College.
3. EHOVE Career Center certifies that the student has successfully completed all the requirements for the specified EHOVE Program with a minimum grade point average of a 3.00 on a 4.00 scale.
4. The EHOVE Career Center student must present their Career Passport to the Dean of Engineering and Industrial Technologies at Terra Community College to be eligible for articulated credit as it applies to his/her major.
5. Students must have achieved a “B” or better average in their EHOVE Program to be eligible for articulated credit
6. The student must apply and enroll at Terra Community College within two years of graduation to be granted eligible articulated credit.

This agreement of articulation shall continue in effect for one academic year, at which time it will be reviewed by EHOVE Career Center and Terra Community College.
