## AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

TERRA STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
ARTS & SCIENCES AND BUSINESS DIVISION

AND

EHOVE CAREER CENTER  
ADULT EDUCATION COSMETOLOGY PROGRAM  
Effective Beginning with 2009 Graduates

This agreement is based on a review of the Cosmetology Program at EHOVE Career Center and the courses taught in the Arts & Sciences and Business Division at Terra State Community College as of the date of this agreement. Upon review of the cosmetology curriculum and evaluation of the content, the following agreement has been established:

Students completing the Cosmetology Program at EHOVE Career Center and passing the licensure examination established by the Ohio State Board of Cosmetology, and having obtained a current Cosmetology license from the Ohio State Board of Cosmetology will receive advanced credit toward an associate degree at Terra State Community College provided they meet the following criteria:

1. An application for admission has been completed and submitted to Terra State Community College.
2. All official secondary and post-secondary transcripts have been filed with the Office of Admissions at Terra Community College.
3. The student has a valid Certificate of Completion from EHOVE Career Center for Cosmetology training.
4. The student is recommended by the Coordinator of the Cosmetology Program at EHOVE.
5. Student must present a signed and valid Certificate of Completion.

Upon successful completion of the Cosmetology course of study at EHOVE Career Center, the student may be eligible for credit at Terra Community College for the following course as it applies to his/her selected major.

- COS 2990, Cosmetology State Licensure

Credit will be awarded using the following processes:

1. Student must present evidence of licensure to the Dean of Arts & Sciences and Business.
2. The courses the student receives credit for will be added to his/her transcript once the student has completed 9 semester hours of 100-level courses with a "C" or better at Terra State Community College.

This agreement of articulation shall continue in effect with reviews by both parties occurring every two years.
