**AGREEMENT OF ARTICULATION
BETWEEN
TERRA STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE
ARTS & SCIENCES AND BUSINESS DIVISION
AND
THE SENTINEL CAREER CENTER
TECH PREP MEDICAL TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM
In Effect for 2011 Graduates**

This agreement is based on a review of the Tech Prep Medical Technology Program at The Sentinel Career Center and the courses taught in the Arts & Sciences and Business Division at Terra State Community College as of the date of this agreement. A joint faculty and administrative discussion, review and evaluation of the content establishes the following agreement:

Students completing the Tech Prep Medical Technology Program at Sentinel Career Center will receive advanced credit towards an associate degree at Terra State Community College provided they meet the following criteria:

1. An application for admission has been completed and submitted to Terra State Community College.
2. All official secondary and post-secondary transcripts have been filed with the Office of Admissions at Terra State Community College.
3. The student has graduated from secondary school with a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale in the Tech Prep Medical Technology Program.
4. The student is recommended by the faculty of the Tech Prep Medical Technology Program.
5. The Sentinel Career Center must certify that the student has successfully completed all the requirements for the Tech Prep Medical Technology Program.

Upon successful completion of the Tech Prep Medical Technology Program, students may be eligible for credit at Terra State Community College for the following courses, as they apply to his/her selected major:

- BIO1200 Introduction to Anatomy and Physiology (*3 semester credits*)
- MED2400 Medical Terminology (*3 semester credits*)

Articulation credit will be awarded using the following process:

1. Articulated credit will be added to the student's transcript once the student has completed the next higher level course and presents his/her Career Passport to the Dean of Arts & Sciences and Business at Terra State Community College. It is the student's responsibility to present their Career Passport to the dean at Terra State Community College
