



**AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
TERRA STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE
BUSINESS, SOCIAL SCIENCES, MATHEMATICS AND THE ARTS DIVISION
AND
VANGUARD-SENTINEL CAREER CENTERS
CCNT PROGRAM
Effective for graduating class of 2003**

This agreement is based on a review of the CCNT Program at Vanguard-Sentinel Career Centers district and the courses taught in the Business, Social Sciences, Mathematics and the Arts Division at Terra State Community College as of the date of this agreement. A joint faculty and administrative discussion, review and evaluation of the content establishes the following agreement:

Students completing the CCNT Program at Vanguard-Sentinel Career Centers at the Tech Center in Fremont will receive advanced credit towards an associate degree at Terra State Community College provided they meet the following criteria:

1. An application for admission has been completed and submitted to Terra State Community College.
2. All official secondary and post-secondary transcripts have been filed with the Office of Admissions at Terra State Community College.
3. The student has graduated from the Career Center with a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale in CCNT.
4. The student is recommended by the faculty of the CCNT Program.
5. Vanguard-Sentinel Career Centers must certify that the student has successfully completed all the requirements for the CCNT Program.

Upon successful completion of the CCNT course of study at the Vanguard-Sentinel Career Center, the student may be eligible for credit at Terra State Community College for the following courses, as it applies to his/her selected major. Students may have the course articulated based on instructor recommendation using the Articulation Check Off Sheet.

- ITS 109, Computer Fundamentals
- CIS 123, Microcomputers I
- CIS 124, Microcomputers II

- CIS 140, CISCO I
- CIS 240, CISCO II
- CIS 241, CISCO III
- CIS 255, Introduction to Networking I
- CIS 264, Introduction to Networking II
- ITS 141, Introduction to Fiber Optics

Credit will be awarded using the following processes:

1. The courses the students receive credit for will be added to their transcript once the student has completed the next higher level course. It is the responsibility of the student to present the Articulation Check Off Sheet to Terra Community College to gain credit.
2. In the event that the course is not a pre-requisite for another course, credit will be awarded upon completion of 12 quarter hours of 100 level courses with a “C” or better at Terra State Community College.

This agreement of articulation shall continue in effect for the 2003 graduates.

Students at the Vanguard-Sentinel Career Center will enroll in the following Terra Community College courses as Tech Prep students:
