**AGREEMENT OF ARTICULATION
BETWEEN
TERRA STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE
ARTS & SCIENCES DIVISION
AND
THE TECHNOLOGY CENTER,
VANGUARD-SENTINEL CAREER CENTERS
TECH PREP MEDICAL CAREERS PROGRAM
In Effect for 2009 Graduates**

This agreement is based on a review of the Tech Prep Medical Careers Program at The Technology Center, Vanguard-Sentinel Career Centers and the courses taught in the Arts & Sciences Division at Terra State Community College as of the date of this agreement. A joint faculty and administrative discussion, review and evaluation of the content establishes the following agreement:

Students completing the Tech Prep Medical Careers Program at the Technology Center will receive advanced credit towards an associate degree at Terra State Community College provided they meet the following criteria:

1. An application for admission has been completed and submitted to Terra State Community College.
2. All official secondary and post-secondary transcripts have been filed with the Office of Admissions at Terra State Community College.
3. The student has graduated from secondary school with a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale in the Tech Prep Medical Careers Program.
4. The student is recommended by the faculty of the Tech Prep Medical Careers Program.
5. The Technology Center, Vanguard-Sentinel Career Centers must certify that the student has successfully completed all the requirements for the Tech Prep Medical Careers Program.

Upon successful completion of the Tech Prep Medical Careers Program, students may be eligible for credit at Terra State Community College for the following courses, as they apply to his/her selected major:

- BIO1200, Introduction to Anatomy and Physiology (*3 semester credits*)
- MED 2400, Medical Terminology (*3 semester credits*)

Articulation credit will be awarded using the following process:

1. Articulated credit will be added to the student's transcript once the student has completed the next higher level course and presents his/her Career Passport to the Dean of Arts and Sciences at Terra State Community College. It is the student's responsibility to present their Career Passport to the dean at Terra State Community College
2. In the event that the course is not a prerequisite for another course, credit will be awarded upon completion of 15 quarter hours or 10 semester hours of 100 level courses with a grade of "C" or better at Terra State Community College.

Students at the Technology Center will enroll in the following Terra Community College courses as part of their Tech Prep Medical Careers program and their grades will be placed on their Terra transcript:

FALL SEMESTER Junior Year

PSY 1210, General Psychology, *3 credits*

GEN 1110, College Success, *1 credit*

SPRING SEMESTER Junior Year

BIO 2100, Nutrition, *3 credits*

FALL SEMESTER Senior Year *

BIO 2010, Biology, *4 credits*

or SOC 2010, Fundamentals of Sociology, *3 credits*

BIO 2015, Biology Lab, *1 credit*

MTH 2700, Medical Careers Math I, *1 credit*

SPRING SEMESTER Senior Year

CHM1010, Introduction to General Chemistry, *3 credits*

CHM 1015, Introduction to General Chemistry Lab, *1 credit*

As per the college catalog, students must have a “C” or better in the first course in a sequence in order to take the next course. This agreement shall continue in effect for one year, at which time it will be reviewed by both parties.
