



ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

**Terra State Community College
Technology and Workforce Development Division
And
Sentinel Career Center in Tiffin, OH
Effective for 2010 Graduates**

This agreement is based on a review of the Computer-Aided Design (CAD) Program at Sentinel Career Center in Tiffin and courses offered in the Mechanical Engineering Technology Division at Terra State Community College as of the date of this agreement. A joint faculty and administrative discussion, review and evaluation of the content established the following agreement:

Students completing the CAD Program at Sentinel Career Center in Tiffin will receive advanced credit, as it applies, towards an associate degree in;

*Manufacturing Engineering
Architectural/Construction Technology*

To be eligible for advanced credit applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. The student must enroll at Terra State Community College within two calendar years after having graduated from the Tech Prep CAD Program of Study at the Career Center in order to be eligible to receive articulated credits defined in this agreement.
2. The student must have graduated from the Tech Prep CAD program at the Career Center with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of a 3.00 (B average) on a 4.00 scale.
3. The student must submit a letter/form to the Dean of Technology and Workforce Development at Terra State Community College signed by the Director of the Career Center stating that the student petitioning for articulated credit has successfully completed the requirements of the secondary two-year Tech Prep CAD program, the date of the student's high school graduation and the Tech Prep CAD program cumulative grade point average.
4. The student submits an official secondary school transcript to the Records Office at Terra State Community College.

Upon successful completion of the two-year CAD Program at Sentinel Career Center, the student will be eligible for articulation credit at Terra State Community College for the following courses as they apply to his/her major:

- CAD 1240 Architectural CAD
- *CAD 1110 CAD I
- *QCT 1020 Blueprint Reading

Articulation credit will be awarded using the following processes:

1. The courses students receive articulated credit for will be added to their transcript once the student has completed the next higher level course and presents his/her Career Passport to the Dean of Technology and Workforce Development at Terra State Community College. It is the student's responsibility to present their Career Passport to Terra State Community College.
2. In the event the course is not a prerequisite for another course, credit will be awarded upon completion of 10 semester hours of 100 level courses with a "C" or better at Terra State Community College.

* Students enrolled in the Sentinel CAD program who are not Tech Prep students may earn articulated credit for CAD 1110 and QCT 1020 after graduation from secondary school and meeting the two above requirements.

Students at Sentinel Career Center will be enrolled in the following Terra State Community College courses while in the Tech Prep program. Students will receive a grade from Terra State Community College for these courses, and the grade will be recorded on the student's permanent transcript at the college. These courses may be applied to an appropriate major leading to an associate degree.

Junior students will enroll in the following courses:

Senior students will enroll in the following courses:
