In Effect for 2008 Graduates**

This agreement is based on a review of the Tech Prep Agribusiness Management Program at Clyde Senior High School and the courses taught in the Arts and Sciences Division at Terra State Community College as of the date of this agreement. A joint faculty and administrative discussion, review and evaluation of the content establishes the following agreement:

Students completing the Tech Prep Agribusiness Management Program at Clyde Senior High School will receive advanced credit towards an associate degree at Terra State Community College provided they meet the following criteria:

1. An application for admission has been completed and submitted to Terra State Community College.
2. All official secondary and post-secondary transcripts have been filed with the Office of Admissions at Terra State Community College.
3. The student has graduated from secondary school with a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale in Agribusiness Management.
4. The student is recommended by the faculty of the Agribusiness Management Program.
5. Clyde Senior High School must certify that the student has successfully completed all the requirements for the Agribusiness Management Program.

Upon successful completion of the Tech Prep Agribusiness Management course of study at Clyde Senior High School, the student will be eligible for credit at Terra State Community College for the following courses, as it applies to his/her selected major.

- AGR1010, Intro to Agribusiness, 3 semester credit hours
- AGR2500, Precision Agriculture Technology, 3 semester credit hours

Credit will be awarded using the following processes:

1. The courses the students receive credit for will be added to their transcript once the student has completed the next higher level course. It is the responsibility of the student to present his/her official transcript to Terra Community College.
2. In the event that the course is not a pre-requisite for another course, credit will be awarded upon completion of 12 semester hours of 100 level courses with a "C" or better at Terra State Community College.

Students at Clyde Senior High School will enroll in the following Terra State Community College courses as Tech Prep students:

AGR270	Laboratory Techniques Of Agriculture	1 semester credit To be taken fall semester	(Junior Year)
AGR1030	Intermediate Agribusiness Management	3 semester credits To be taken spring semester	(Junior Year)
AGR2000	Agronomy & Soil Science	3 semester credits To be taken fall semester	(Senior Year)
AGR2150	Crop & Pest Management	3 semester credits To be taken spring semester	(Senior Year)

The grades for the above courses will be placed on the student's Terra transcript.

This agreement of articulation shall be in effect for the 2008 graduates. If changes in the curriculum (such as significant changes to a course's content) at Terra warrant, this agreement may be modified.
