### **Terra's Kern Center Offering Instructor-Led IT Certification Courses**

The following list includes the instructor-led IT certification courses this fall:

- **A+ Certification-Essentials** – The Essentials Exam validates the basic skills needed by any entry-level service technician. This is a hands-on class. The books and exam are included in the fee. 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. Saturdays for seven sessions beginning Aug. 29. Cost: \$549.
- **A+ Certification-IT Technician** – The CompTIA A+ 220-602 exam is targeted for individuals who work or intend to work in a mobile or corporate technical environment with a high level of face-to-face client interaction. 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. Saturdays for seven sessions beginning Oct. 24. Cost: \$549.
- **Network + (Online)** – This course will teach you everything you need to know to take and pass the challenging CompTIA Network + certification exam and become an excellent network technician.
