- **CDL Classes** – This class is for anyone interested in obtaining their Commercial Driver's License. Classes will meet Mondays in December at 9 a.m.
- **Transformation Network** – 9 to 11:30 a.m. Tuesdays in November. Program for anyone with felonies or misdemeanors. Must fill out a referral in the Job Store.
