



**AGREEMENT OF ARTICULATION
BETWEEN
TERRA STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE
BUSINESS, SOCIAL SCIENCES, MATHEMATICS AND THE ARTS DIVISION
AND
VANGUARD-SENTINEL JOINT VOCATIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT
MEDICAL CAREERS PROGRAM
In Effect for 2004 Graduates**

This agreement is based on a review of the Medical Careers Program at Vanguard-Sentinel Joint Vocational School district and the courses taught in the Business, Social Sciences, Mathematics and the Arts Division at Terra State Community College as of the date of this agreement. A joint faculty and administrative discussion, review and evaluation of the content establishes the following agreement:

Students completing the Medical Careers Program at Vanguard-Sentinel Joint Vocational School in Fremont will receive advanced credit towards an associate degree at Terra State Community College provided they meet the following criteria:

1. An application for admission has been completed and submitted to Terra State Community College.
2. All official secondary and post-secondary transcripts have been filed with the Office of Admissions at Terra State Community College.
3. The student has graduated from secondary school with a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale in Medical Careers.
4. The student is recommended by the faculty of the Medical Careers Program.
5. Vanguard-Sentinel Joint Vocational School district must certify that the student has successfully completed all the requirements for the Medical Careers Program.

This agreement shall continue in effect for one year, at which time it will be reviewed by both parties.

Students at the Vanguard-Sentinel Career Center will enroll in the following Terra Community College courses as Tech Prep students:

CHM 105	4 credits (Junior Year) To be taken fall quarter
CHM 106	4 credits (Junior Year) To be taken winter quarter
CHM 107	4 credits (Junior Year) To be taken spring quarter
BIO 101/102	4 credits (Senior Year) To be taken fall quarter
BIO 103/104	4 credits (Senior Year) To be taken winter quarter
BIO 105/106	4 credits (Senior Year) To be taken spring quarter

The grades for the above courses will be placed on the student's Terra transcript.
