



**AGREEMENT OF ARTICULATION

AND
VANGUARD-SENTINEL CAREER CENTERS
TECH PREP CCNT PROGRAM
In effect for 2006 Graduates**

This agreement is based on a review of the Tech Prep CCNT Program at the Technology Center, Vanguard-Sentinel Career Centers in Fremont and the courses taught in the Business and Public Service Technologies Division at Terra State Community College as of the date of this agreement. A joint faculty and administrative discussion, review, and evaluation of the content established the following agreement.

A student completing the Tech Prep CCNT Program at the Technology Center will receive advanced credit towards an associate degree at Terra State Community College provided that he/she meets the following criteria:

1. An application for admission has been completed and submitted to Terra State Community College.
2. All official secondary and post-secondary transcripts have been filed with the Office of Enrollment Services at Terra State Community College.
3. The student has graduated from secondary school with a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale in the Tech Prep CCNT Program.
4. The student is recommended by the faculty of the Tech Prep CCNT Program.
5. Technology Center, Vanguard-Sentinel Career Centers must certify that the student has successfully completed all the requirements for the CCNT Program.

Tech Prep CCNT students at the Technology Center will enroll in the following Terra State Community College courses as part of their Tech Prep CCNT program. The student's grades for the following courses will be placed on his/her Terra State Community College transcript.

Upon successful completion of the CCNT course of study at the Technology Center, the student may be eligible for additional credit for several Terra State Community College courses, as they apply to his/her selected major. The student will receive additional credit for the following three courses. They will be added to his/her transcript once the student has presented his/her **“Career Passport”** to the Dean or Associate Dean of the Business and Public Service Technologies Division at Terra State Community College.

- CIS 140, CISCO I
- CIS 240, CISCO II

Upon completion of the Tech Prep CCNT course of study at the Technology Center, the student may also be eligible for additional Terra State Community College credit based on completion of industry-accepted certifications or Terra proficiency tests. A copy of all student certifications should be kept within the **“Career Passport.”** The student will have the following credit added to his/her transcript upon presentation of his/her Passport containing the following certifications or proficiencies.
