



ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

**Terra State Community College
Business Technologies Division
And
Sentinel Career Center in Tiffin Ohio
Effective for 2007 Graduates**

This agreement is based on a review of the Tech Prep CCNT Program at the Sentinel Career Center in Tiffin and courses taught in the Business Technologies Division and the Engineering and Industrial Technology Division at Terra State Community College as of the date of this agreement. A joint faculty and administrative discussion, review and evaluation of the content establishes the following agreement:

Students completing the Tech Prep CCNT Program at the Sentinel Career Center in Tiffin will receive advanced credit towards an associate degree at Terra State Community College provided they meet the following criteria:

1. The student has graduated from the secondary school with a minimum grade point average of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale in the CCNT Program.
2. Official transcripts have been submitted to the Registrar's Office at Terra State Community College.
3. The student is recommended by the CCNT faculty.
4. The Sentinel Career Center has certified that the student has successfully completed all the requirements for the CCNT Program.

Upon successful completion of the CCNT Program at the Sentinel Career Center in Tiffin, the student will be eligible for articulation credit at Terra State Community College for the following courses as they apply to his/her selected major.

- CIT 1090 Computer Fundamentals 3 credits
- CIT 1240 Microcomputers 4 credits
- CIT 1400 Networking I 4 credits

Articulation credit will be awarded using the following processes:

1. The CCNT faculty at the Sentinel Career Center has signed off, indicating that the student has acquired all necessary competencies.

2. The courses students receive articulated credit for will be added to their transcript once the student has completed the next higher level course and presents his/her Career Passport to the Dean of Business Technologies at Terra State Community College. It is the student's responsibility to present their Career Passport to Terra State Community College.
3. In the event that the course is not a prerequisite for another course, credit will be awarded upon completion of 10 semester hours of 1000 level courses with a "C" or better at Terra State Community College.
4. A student may also receive credit for CIT 2400, Networking II, if he/she has achieved CCNA Certification.

Students at the Sentinel Career Center in Tiffin will be enrolled in the following Terra State Community College courses while in the Tech Prep program. Students will receive their grades from Terra State Community College for these courses, and the grade will be recorded on the student's permanent transcript at the College. These courses may be applied to an appropriate major leading to an associate degree.

Junior students will enroll in the following courses:

Senior students will enroll in the following courses:
