



**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
TERRA COMMUNITY COLLEGE
BUSINESS TECHNOLOGIES DIVISION
AND
Vanguard/Sentinel Career Center
MEDICAL AIDE PROGRAM
Effective with 2007 Graduates**

This agreement is based on a review of the Medical Aide Program at the Vanguard-Sentinel Career Center in Fremont and the course taught in the Business Technologies Division at Terra Community College as of the date of this agreement. A joint faculty and administrative discussion, review, and evaluation of the curriculum content established the following agreement:

A student completing the Medical Aide Program at the Vanguard/Sentinel Career Center in Fremont will receive advanced credit towards an associate degree at Terra Community College provided s/he meets the following criteria:

1. An application for admission has been completed and submitted to Terra Community College.
2. All official secondary and post-secondary transcripts have been filed with the Office of Admissions at Terra Community College.
3. The student has graduated from secondary school with a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale in the Medical Aide Program.
4. The student is recommended by the faculty of the Vanguard program.
5. Vanguard-Sentinel Career Center in Fremont certifies that the student has successfully completed all the requirements for the Medical Terminology Program.

Upon completion of the above criteria, credit will be granted for the following class:

- MED 2400, Medical Terminology

Credit will be granted and applied to the student's transcript when the student meets the requirements stated in this agreement and presents his/her Career Passport to the Dean or Associate Dean of the Business Technologies and Workforce Development Division.

This agreement is valid for a student who begins classes at Terra Community College within two years of his/her high school graduation. After that time, a student will be required to meet with a faculty member in the appropriate Terra Community College program to determine what credit may be granted.

This articulation agreement will be reviewed annually by both parties.
