



**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
TERRA STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
ARTS AND SCIENCES DIVISION  
AND  
PIONEER CAREER AND TECHNOLOGY CENTER  
EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION PROGRAM  
Effective with 2006-2007 Graduates**

This agreement is based on a review of the Early Childhood Education Program at the Pioneer Career and Technology Center and the courses taught in the Arts and Sciences Division at Terra State Community College as of the date of this agreement. A joint faculty and administrative discussion, review and evaluation of the content establishes the following agreement:

A student completing the Early Childhood Education Program at the Pioneer Career and Technology Center will receive advanced credit towards an associate degree at Terra State Community College provided he/she meets the following criteria:

1. An application for admission has been completed and submitted to Terra State Community College.
2. All official secondary and post-secondary transcripts have been filed with the Office of Admissions at Terra State Community College.
3. The student has graduated from secondary school with a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale in Early Childhood Education.
4. The student is recommended by the faculty of the Early Childhood Education program.
5. Pioneer Career and Technology Center certifies that the student has successfully completed all the requirements for the Early Childhood Education program.

Upon completion of the Early Childhood Education course of study at the Pioneer Career and Technology Center, the student may be eligible for credit at Terra State Community College for several Early Childhood Education courses, as they apply to his/her selected major.

Several courses will articulate upon presentation of the student's Career Passport to Terra State Community College Early Childhood Education professor(s). If the professor believes that the student's work satisfies the requirements of the course, credit will be awarded for:

ECE 1000, Introduction to Early Childhood Education (3 credits)  
ECE 2030, Nutrition, Health and Safety (3 credits)

Credit will be awarded using the following processes:

1. The courses the student receives credit for will be added to their transcript once the student has completed the next higher level course.
2. In the event that the course is not a prerequisite for another course, credit will be awarded upon completion of 10 semester hours of 1000 level courses with a "C" or better at Terra State Community College.

This articulation agreement shall continue in effect for two years, at which time it will be reviewed by both parties.
