



FAQs ABOUT THE GOAL ORIENTED FLAT RATE TUITION PROGRAM TAKE 18 PAY FOR 12

1. What is the Goal Oriented Tuition Program?

The tuition for one to eleven hours is indexed to the current tuition rate, you will be charged for every credit taken up to twelve. **There is a flat rate for twelve to eighteen (12-18) credit hours.** Anything over eighteen (18) is indexed at the current per hour tuition rate, you will be charged for every credit over eighteen.

The full-time flat rate tuition allows students to take more semester course hours and not be charged an additional amount. This can reduce time to graduation, which reduces the total education costs for students and their families.

This program has increased the number of hours that students take and has helped increase graduation rates.

2. Who is eligible for the Goal Oriented Flat Rate Tuition Program?

All students who enroll full time (**12-18 credit hours**) in a fall or spring semester.

3. When did the Goal Oriented Tuition program begin?

The program started with full time students in the spring of 2015.

4. Can I attend in the summer and get the tuition program?

Yes, but only if you are full-time.

5. What if I start at Terra State in the summer?

If you start in summer 2015 term but don't take a full-time load, you can begin the tuition program in the immediate fall semester after your first summer semester.

6. Do I have to be an Ohio resident to get the tuition program?

No. All full time students who begin in the fall or spring are eligible.

7. Can I take developmental education courses toward the 12-18 hours each semester?

Yes. All credit courses are included in the 12-18 hours, including developmental education.

8. What if I don't enroll full-time?

If you don't enroll full-time (12-18 credit hours), you will be charged the current indexed rate of tuition for the semester depending on the number of credit hours taken. The best value is full-time.

9. What if I enroll full-time and then drop a course?

If you drop a course during the semester and are no longer enrolled full-time, you will be charged the current rate of tuition for the semester in which you enroll less than full time.

10. Why is Terra State offering a Goal Oriented Tuition Program?

The Tuition Program is intended to encourage you to stay at Terra State Community College until you complete your degree or certificate. It is an incentive for you to enroll full-time and it is a tool to help you plan your tuition payments. Completing your degree and achieving your goal in a timely fashion is the primary purpose.
