


Financial Aid Banner Self Service

First log into Terra Single Sign-on from the web site my.terra.edu with your Terra State username and password (1). Select Banner Self Service at the bottom of the screen (2). In order to properly apply financial aid to an account, students need to indicate their preference to authorize or restrict use of their financial aid funds.

Under federal law, the College must receive your authorization to cover fees other than instructional, surcharge, general, lab, registration and activity fees. These other fees are called authorized allowable charges and can include, but are not limited to transferring excess aid to the ID card to purchase books, supplies and meals, background and finger printing fees, library fees and fines, Program clothing and equipment, etc.

• **If a student does not authorize/restrict, The College must assume that the student wishes to restrict use of their financial aid funds.** Restricted funds only cover instructional, surcharge, general, lab, registration and activity fees.

• **If a student chooses to restrict use of their federal title IV financial aid such as government loans, grants, etc.** these cannot be used to pay for charges such as transferring excess aid to the ID card, background and finger printing fee, library fees and fines, etc. As a result, students may receive a refund of financial aid, but still owe a balance for these fees. It will be the student's responsibility to check their account on-line and pay any balance due. Payments are due by the specified registration payment due date. Monthly charges are due by the date shown on the statement of account. Late payment fees can also be assessed if an account is past due.

• **By choosing to "authorize", a student also agrees to allow The College to use current-year funds to satisfy prior award year charges for tuition and fees (and with permission, educationally related charges) for a total of not more than \$200.** The college will not pay prior year charges in excess of \$200.
