## POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

## ACADEMIC STANDING

Effective 2/25/04

(A) A STUDENT MAINTAINS SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS IF, AFTER ATTEMPTING 15 CREDIT HOURS OR MORE, THE MINIMUM CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) MEETS MINIMUM STANDARDS AS FOLLOWS:

TOTAL HOURS ATTEMPTED	<u>MINIMUM</u>
<b>CUMULATIVE GPA</b>	
15	1.5
16-30	1.6
31-45	<b>1.7</b>
46-60	1.8
61-75	1.9
<b>76</b> +	2.0

## Procedures

- 1. The student's academic record shall be reviewed by the Dean of Student Development / Registrar at the end of fall and spring quarters.
- 2. If a student's cumulative academic record does not meet the defined minimum standards, the student is placed on Academic Probation.
- 3. Students have one quarter to raise their GPA. At the end of the first probationary period, the Dean of Student Development/Registrar determines whether to lift the probationary status, to continue the student on probation, or to recommend academic dismissal.
- (A) A student may be continued on probation after one quarter if the quarterly grade point average is raised to a 2.0 or higher, but the cumulative GPA remains below the satisfactory academic progress standards.
