

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT**  
**Lourdes University & Terra State Community College**  
**RN to BSN & RN to MSN Programs**

It is mutually agreed by Lourdes University and Terra State Community College that Lourdes University will accept transfer credit from Terra State Community College.

Lourdes will accept transfer credits up to 50% of the credit hours required for a Bachelor's degree at the grade of C (2.0) or above for admission to the RN to BSN program or 2.75 or above for the RN to MSN program and will allocate specific credit as it meets program requirements. Requirements of admission to the Nursing Program BSN (RN to BSN) or MSN (RN to MSN) include:

- Admission to Lourdes University
- Graduate from the accredited Associate Degree Registered Nurse program at Terra State Community College
- Cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or above for admission to the RN to BSN program or 2.75 or above for the RN to MSN program
- Active, current license to practice as a Registered Nurse
- Applications are subject to additional requirements in each of the individual Lourdes University nursing programs.

The allocation of advanced credit to the program will be the responsibility of the Lourdes University College of Nursing Chair of the Undergraduate Nursing program for the RN to BSN program and the Lourdes University College of Nursing Director of the MSN Nursing program for the RN to MSN program, subject to the approval of the Provost of Lourdes University.

Terra State Community College will retain full responsibility for the educational program of its students. Furthermore, Terra State Community College should inform Lourdes of changes in the curriculum or changes in the availability of learning opportunities as far in advance of the time of the change as is feasible. Failure to do so may prevent the articulation or transfer of credit. If a change is made in the outline of one of the Terra State Community College courses referenced in the Articulation Agreement, the change will be summarized and recorded as an addendum to the agreement. Such action will not require re-approval of the document.

Lourdes University will retain full responsibility for the educational program of its students. Furthermore, Lourdes University should inform Terra State Community College of changes in the curriculum or changes in the availability of learning opportunities as far in advance of the time of the change as is feasible. If a change is made in the outline of one of the Lourdes University courses referenced in the Articulation Agreement, the change will be summarized and recorded as an addendum to the agreement. Such action will not require re-approval of the document.

The faculty and staff of both institutions are encouraged to visit each institution to plan, survey, observe and/or participate in conference with students and/or faculty.

A periodic review of the agreement and the curriculum of both Lourdes University and Terra State Community College will be made by representatives from each institution.

This Articulation Agreement may be terminated by either party upon written notice to the other six (6) calendar months prior to the desired date of termination.

This Articulation Agreement will be in effect beginning October 11, 2013 and will be reviewed periodically to ensure any updates of courses from either institution are reflected for accuracy (unless terminated as stated previously).



**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT**  
**Lourdes University & Terra Community College**  
**Social Work**

It is mutually agreed on this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of MARCH, 2015 by Lourdes University (LU) and Terra Community College (TCC) that the Lourdes University Department of Social Work will accept eligible transfer credit from Terra Community College toward an LU Bachelor's Degree in Social Work (BSW) as set forth in this Articulation Agreement and the attached Equivalency Chart (collectively, the "Agreement").

For each transfer student from TCC, Lourdes will transfer up to 50% of the credit hours required for a BSW from eligible TCC coursework completed at a grade of C (2.0) or better. For each LU transfer student from TCC, sixteen (16) of the required 32 upper level (300/400) semester hours must be completed at Lourdes University for BSW consideration. Specific transfer credits will be allocated in accordance with the Equivalency Chart, as amended from time to time and duly executed by both parties; additional BSW requirements are set forth in the Lourdes University Academic Catalog, available at [http://www.lourdes.edu/Portals/0/Files/Academics/Catalogs/Catalog2014\\_15.pdf](http://www.lourdes.edu/Portals/0/Files/Academics/Catalogs/Catalog2014_15.pdf).


The allocation of upper level to the program will be the responsibility of the LU Social Work Department Program coordinator, subject to the approval of the Provost of Lourdes University.

TCC and LU will each retain full responsibility for their own education programs. Furthermore, LU and TCC shall advise each other regarding any relevant curriculum changes that may affect transfer credit prior to each change and shall endeavor to do so well in advance of the change, as failure to do so may prevent the transfer of credit.


Though it understood the each party is an Independent Contractor and not an agent authorized to bind the other in any way, the faculty and staff of both institutions are encouraged to visit the other institution to plan, survey, observe and/or participate in relevant conferences with students and/or faculty.

An annual review of this Agreement and the curriculum of both Lourdes University and Terra Community College shall be conducted by representatives from each institution. This Agreement is effective as of the date set forth above and may be terminated by either party upon written notice to the other six (6) calendar months prior to the desired date of termination. 
