### Terra Village

---

Terra State's Board of Trustees have given final approval for construction of student housing tentatively named "Terra Village." A groundbreaking ceremony is planned for June 28 with construction beginning on July 1.

The building will be located just east of SR 53 and north of Terra Boulevard. The 200-bed residence hall will include four room options for students—1-bed studio, 2-bed single, 2-bed double and 4-bed. Each unit will have its own living, kitchen and bathroom areas. The variety of room offerings will allow for different price points to fit the needs of the students. Outside, students will find benches for a quiet study area, outdoor grills, an outdoor television and other games.

In addition to the residential offerings, there will be a 5,000 square foot retail component that can be used for businesses, such as the bookstore, bank or café.

The new facility will begin housing student at the start of the 2018 Fall semester.
