Menus can be found each Monday on the Terra State Facebook page. Ask the Tree Tops Café cashier about beverage cards. It's a great way to earn free beverages.




Transfer reps schedule

Terra State student Jeremiah McGowan, of Risingsun, has been selected to receive a \$1,000 scholarship from Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society as a 2015 Coca-Cola Leaders of Promise Scholar.


Selected as 2015 Coca-Cola Leaders of Promise Scholars, 207 Phi Theta Kappa members have been awarded a total of \$207,000 in scholarships. Chosen from more than 1,100 applications worldwide, the scholars receive scholarships of \$1,000 each to further their associate degree studies. Independent judges evaluate the applications based on scholastic achievement, community service and leadership potential.

Jeremiah is a Lakota High School graduate and is majoring in mechanical engineering at Terra State. He plans to transfer to The Ohio State University to pursue a degree in aerospace engineering. At Terra, he is vice president of Phi Theta Kappa, a student government senator and a student employee in the Academic Service Center.
